Here's what each grade level has been working on in November:

Students in all grades had the opportunity to write letters and make cards for veterans or service members following our Veterans Day Assembly. I collected them and mailed them to Operation Gratitude who then includes them in their care packages that they send. This year, we sent approximately 275 letters and cards to them.

5th 1-Point Perspective

Students continued with perspective, learning how to make a street or buildings from different points-of-view.

4th Keith Haring Figures

Students used their knowledge of figure drawing to begin 2 different projects using either a monochromatic, complementary, or analogous color scheme. The students included ideas from Haring's artwork in their designs.

3rd Season Trees

Students created a very large tree drawing and traced it with oil pastels and painted the background with watercolor paints.

2nd Watercolor Leaves

Students began using their watercolors to paint their leaves using a warm and cool color scheme.

1st Turtle Color Wheels

Students attached their color wheel turtle to the sand and sea background. They learned how to complete the self-evaluation form to assess their own strengths and weaknesses for this project.
